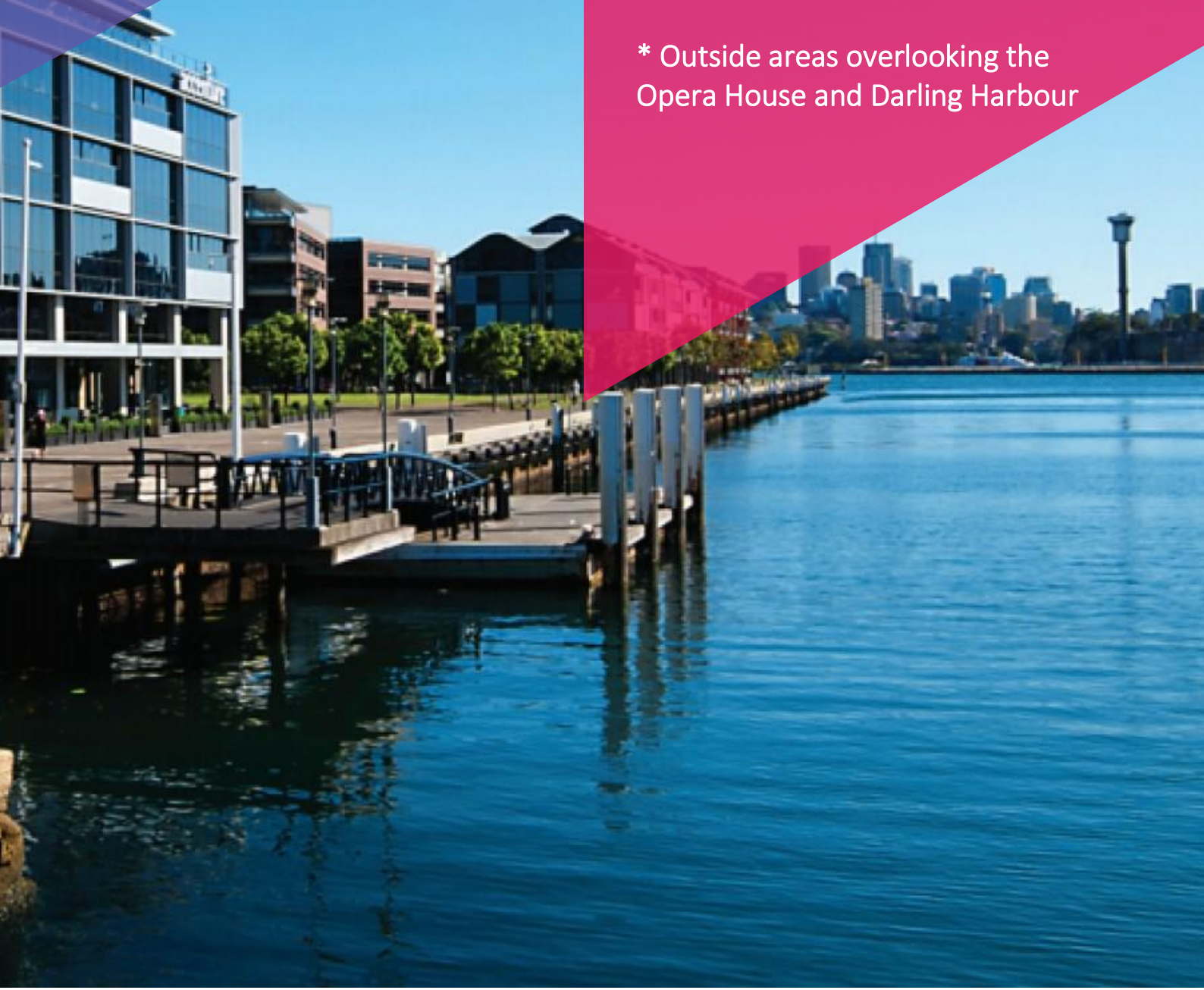
Home Facility – Doltone House

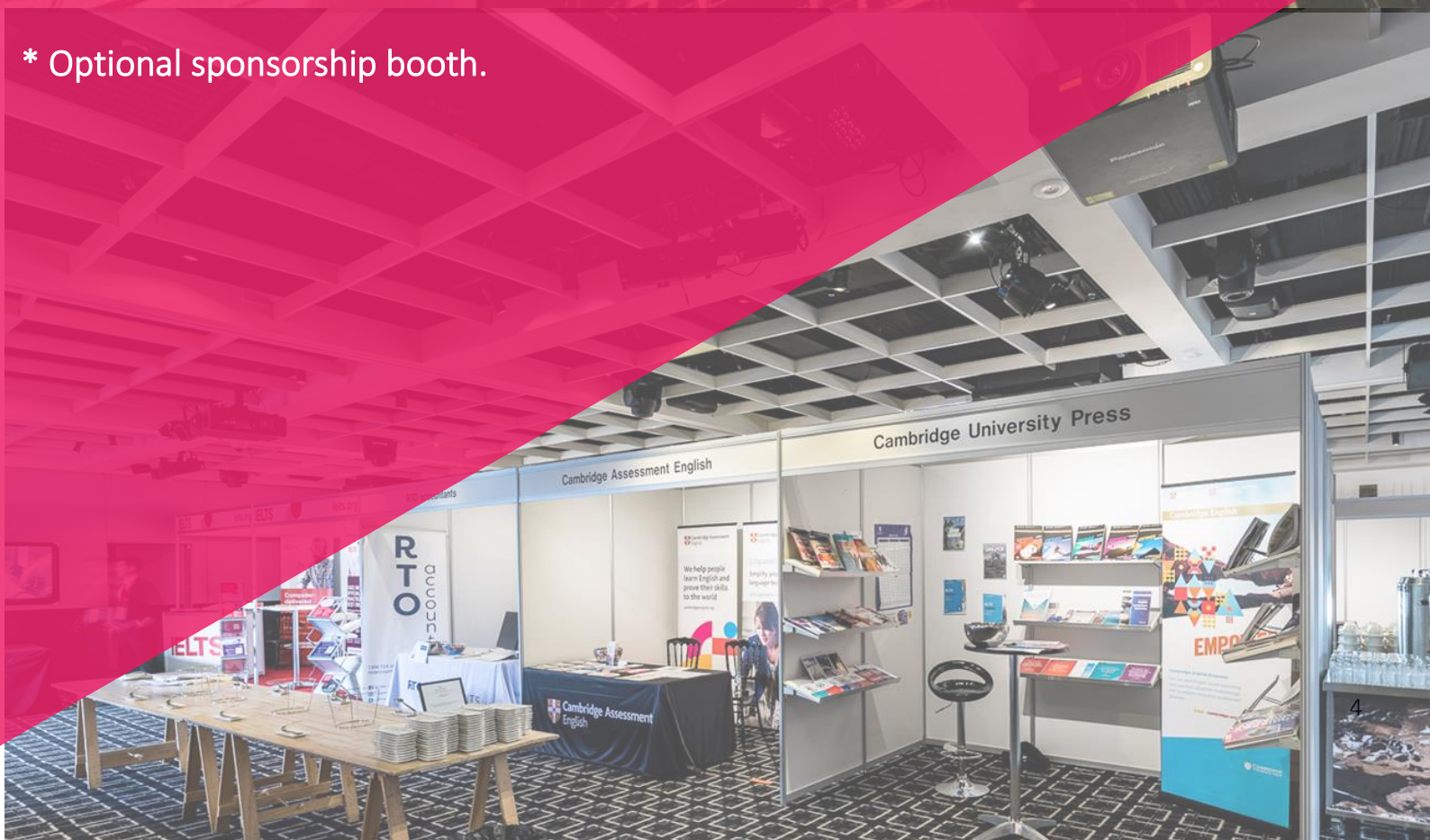

DESIRED CONFERENCE OUTCOMES

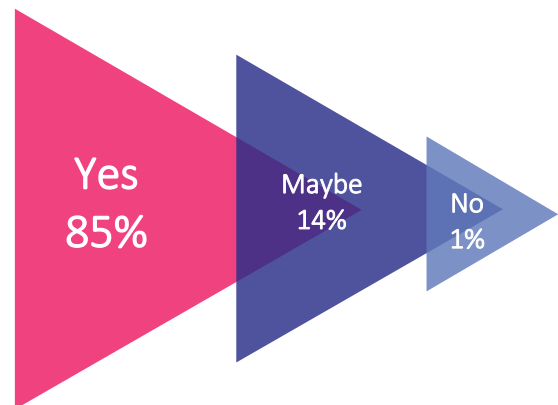
1. Give delegates the opportunity to provide their research and opinion to a large audience within the ELT sector.

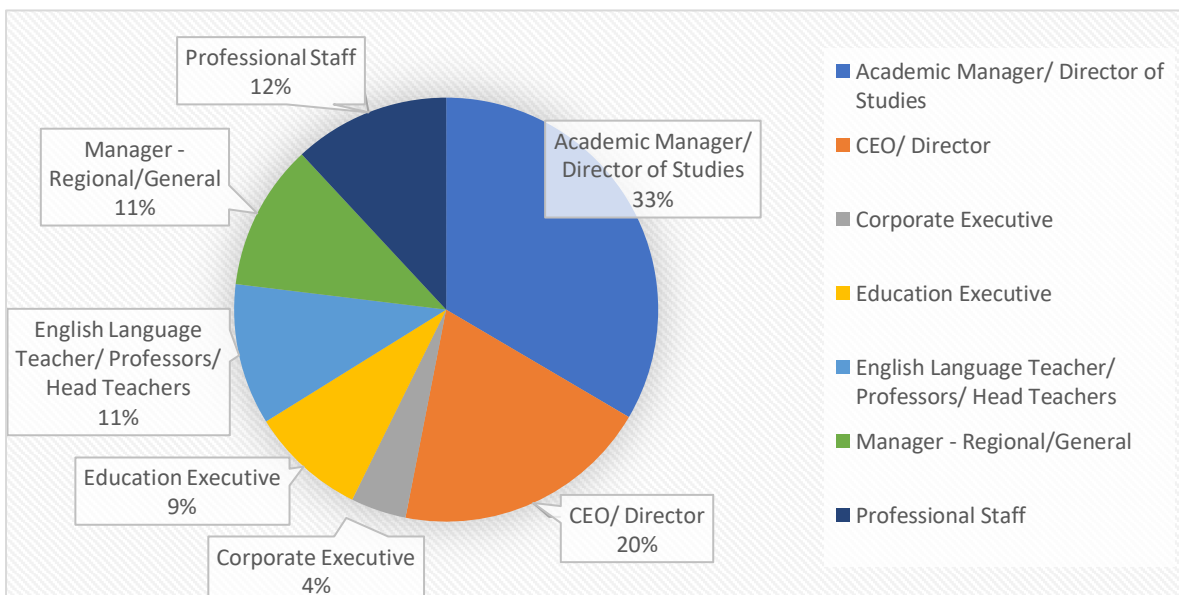
In 2019 we had our highest attendee rate – 329! We continue to grow each year showcasing new initiatives, high profile speakers and on-trend topics relevant to our delegates.

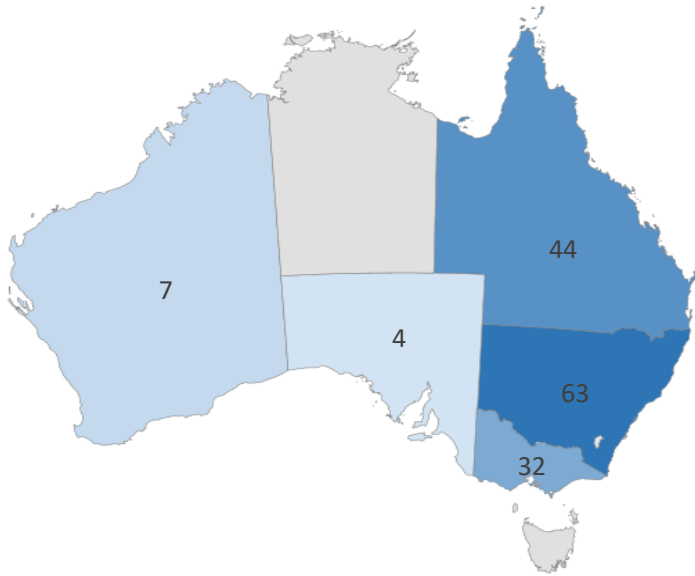

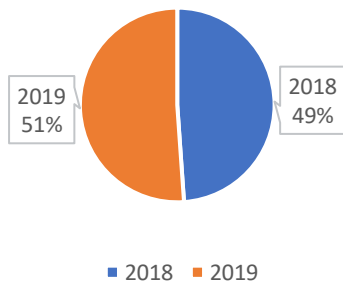

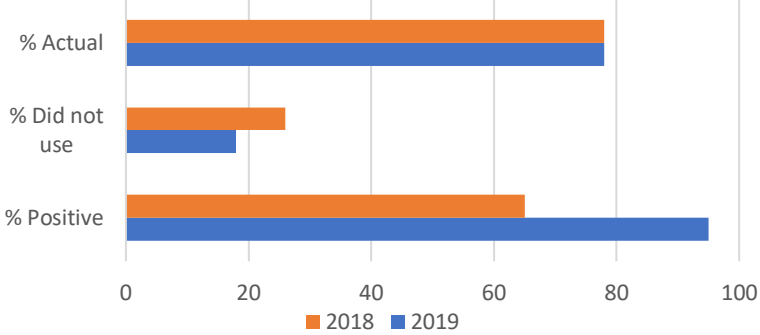
% Conference Satisfaction

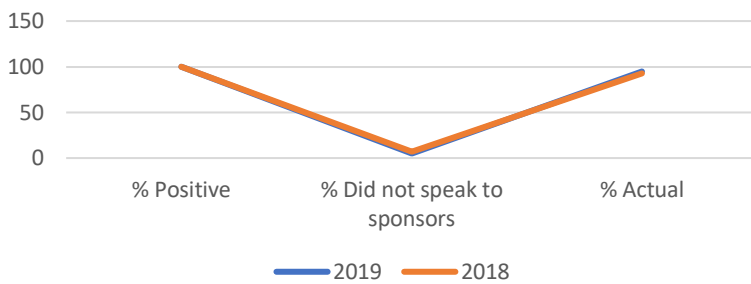

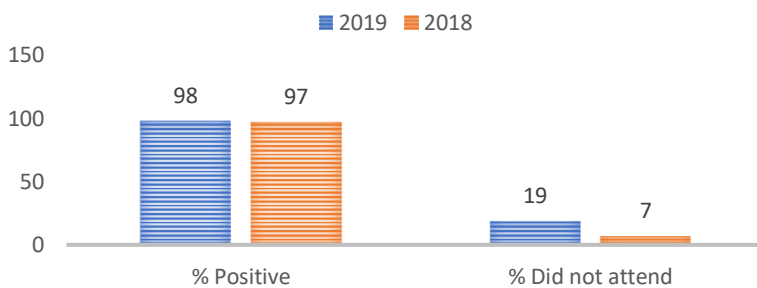
