Graduate Certificate of TESOL

The Graduate Certificate of TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) is a course designed for prospective teacher wishing to teach English to speakers of other languages in a variety of contexts. The course is offered in the Department of Linguistics, ranked 28th in the world (QS University Ranking by subject). It integrates current theory and practice of TESOL, including teaching methodologies, second language acquisition, and linguistics for language teaching.
